Starting with the upbeat "Joshua Fit The Battle Of Jerico," they will get your toe to tapping with their close harmonies. "I'll Keep Holding On To Jesus" follows, then "Everyday Will Be Sunday". Neil Enloe's "Lost, Searching, Found" leads into a great rendition of the classic, "Down By The Riverside". Anita takes the lead on "The Place Of Prayer" and "I'm The Lamb" features Terry.
